- **The plan focuses on four key areas**
 - **Ending coal pollution**
 - **Establishing a carbon price and levy**
 - **Capping oil sands emissions**
 - **Reducing methane emissions**
- **Specific recommendations on energy efficiency**

Energy Efficiency

- **The Climate Change Advisory Panel made recommendations on the role of energy efficiency:**
 - **Create a dedicated agency – Energy Efficiency Alberta**
 - **Ensure that community-scale energy systems are included in the mandate of the agency**
 - **Look at a range of options for the promotion of energy efficiency, including, but not limited to;**
 - Education and Outreach
 - Incentives
 - Audits

Energy Efficiency Alberta

- **Energy Efficiency Alberta is being established to;**
 - **to promote, raise awareness about, and design and deliver programs on the efficient use of energy, the conservation of energy and the development of community energy systems in all sectors of the Province.**
- **Budget of \$645 million for five years beginning in 2016-17**
- **The first year budget is set at \$45 million**
- **Subsequent year budgets**
 - 2017-2018: \$90M
 - 2018-2019: \$165M
 - 2019-2020: \$170M
 - 2020/2021: \$175M

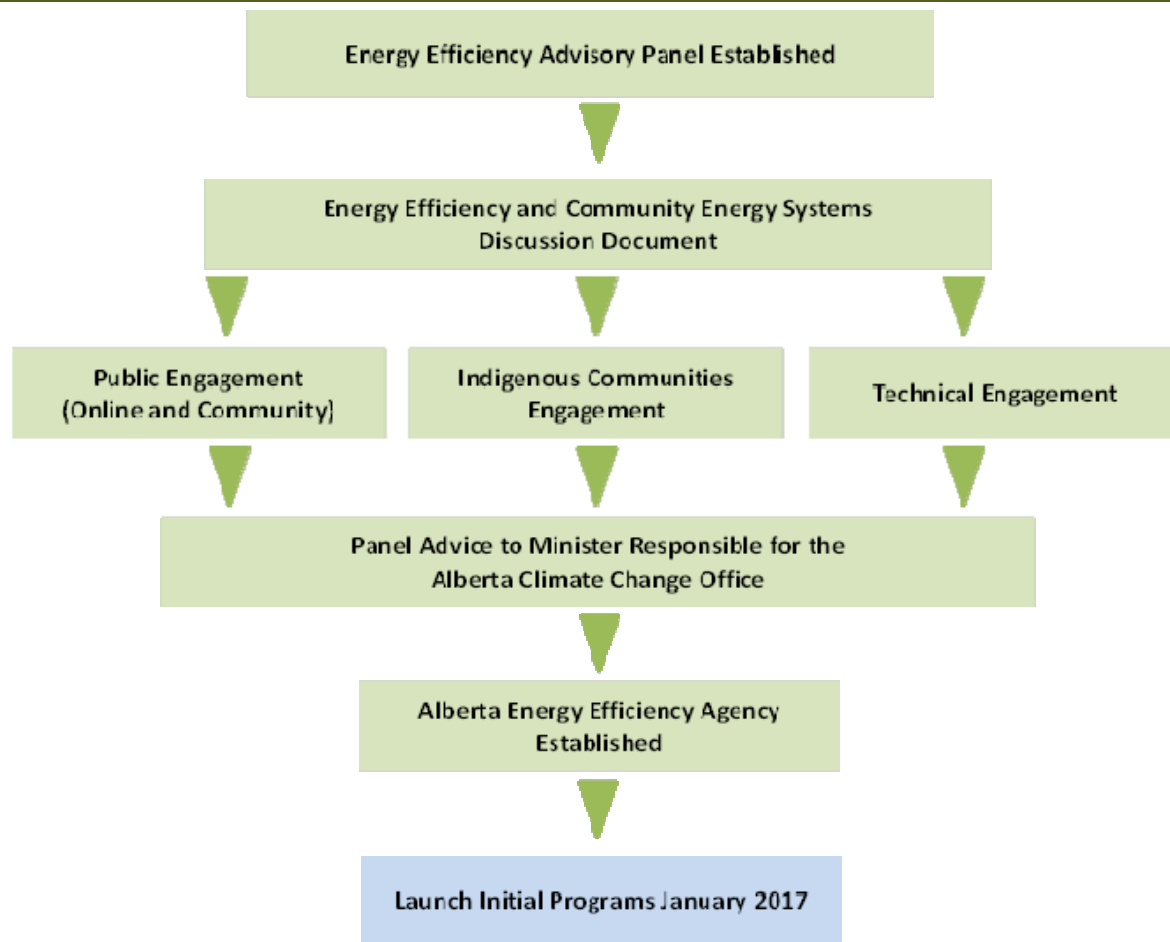
Energy Efficiency Advisory Panel
