Circuit Rider Trainer (Water/Wastewater Systems), Central Alberta

First Nations Technical Services Advisory Group (TSAG) provides technical services and training for Alberta First Nations in the Treaty 6, 7 and 8 Regions.

TSAG is seeking a highly-motivated individual to take on the responsibility of a fulltime Circuit Rider Trainer (CRT) whom will join 7 other Circuit Riders currently spread out across Alberta. This CRT position will work with multiple First Nations communities in Central Alberta, will report directly to the Circuit Rider Training Program Manager and will be responsible for planning, organizing and delivering a variety of mentoring and training needs for First Nation water and wastewater system operators including:

- Hands-on training in proper operation and maintenance of various types of water & wastewater systems such as: class I water treatment systems, class II conventional water treatment system(s), class II membrane water treatment system(s), class I & II water distribution systems, class I wastewater collection systems and class I wastewater treatment lagoons;
- Training operators how to troubleshoot mechanical, electrical and safety equipment;
- Provide site visit reports, observations, and plant efficiency recommendations;
- Assist with development of maintenance management plans (MMP's) and emergency response plans (ERP's);
- Assist with development of Operations and Maintenance (O&M) budgets;
- Service remote water monitoring equipment as required;
- Identify, rectify and monitor deficiencies;
- Participate in provision of 24/7 technical support to First Nations water and wastewater systems;
- Willing to travel throughout Alberta including remote locations. May be required to remain onsite for longer periods of time (up to 5 days) and also willing to occasionally work on weekends;
- Perform other duties as required.

Skills / Experience required include:

- Minimum grade 12 or equivalent certificate;
- Minimum of Level II Water Treatment certification and Level I in all other fields of certification which include: Water Distribution, Wastewater Collection and Wastewater Treatment, and must also be willing and have the ability to upgrade certification levels during the course of employment to match levels of systems in circuit;
- Minimum of 10 years' experience in water and wastewater field, supervisory experience would be an asset;
- Ability to effectively communicate both verbally and in writing;
- Computer skills would be a definite asset;
- Excellent knowledge of biology, chemistry and hydraulics as it relates to water and wastewater treatment systems;
- Knowledge of SCADA systems, PLC's and HMI's;

- Instrumentation experience would be an asset;
- Good mechanical aptitude;
- Strong problem solving and troubleshooting;
- Punctual and reliable team player;
- Safety training in various areas, such as confined space entry, safety training will also be provided as required.

Conditions of employment:

- Must currently hold Alberta Environment & Parks Certification with a minimum of Level II Water Treatment, and Level I Water Distribution, Wastewater Collection and Wastewater Treatment certification;
- Hold a Valid Class 5 Vehicle Operators license and able to provide a driver abstract, as well as have a reliable and insured four-wheel drive vehicle;
- Provide evidence of successfully passing an R.C.M.P Criminal Record Check;
- This position will be located in Central Alberta (Edmonton area) and is a permanent full-time position, with the successful applicant being required to live in the area to be within a 2-hour response of the assigned water/wastewater systems.
