- Hound Sense & TSAG Collaboration



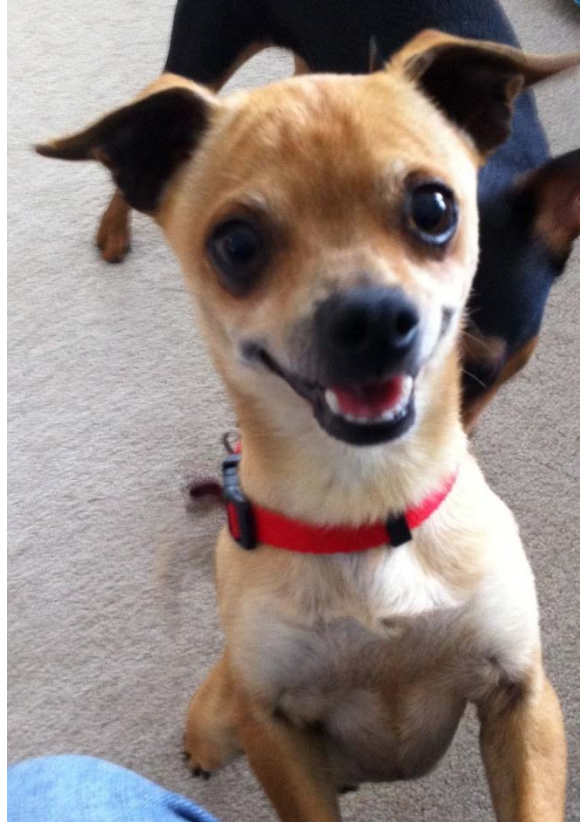
