

Onsite Wastewater Training Program

The First Nations Technical Services Group Inc. (TSAG) provides technical services and training for Alberta First Nations in the Treaty 6, Treaty 7, and Treaty 8 areas.

TSAG and AOWMA is offering a **10-day training** program to First Nation Technicians who want to obtain their **Onsite Wastewater Training Certificate**.

Participants who pass may apply for their Certificate of Competency with Alberta Municipal Affairs to design and install septic systems. Also, Water Operators with Level I or II can use this course towards their required CEUs.

Technicians must be able to attend all 10 training days (one week training, one week home, one week training).

- Grade 10 reading level is recommended
- Math Tutoring available in evenings
- Site & Soils Field Training Day
