First Nations Technical Services Advisory Group (TSAG) provides technical services and training for Alberta First Nations in the Treaty 6, Treaty 7, and Treaty 8 areas.

This course has both classroom and field components and is intended for operators who are handling solid waste.

- Optimal Solid Waste Management practices
- Basic Design Elements of a Landfill/Transfer Station
- Federal, Provincial, and Municipal landfill and HHW regulations
- The nine TDG classifications of Hazardous Wastes
- The new Globally Harmonized System (GHS)
- WHMIS and GHS differentiation
- Hazardous Waste categorization
- Ozone Depleting Substances: recognition and proper disposal

Open-toe and high-heel shoes are NOT permitted.

A certificate of completion (1.2 CEUs) will be provided upon completion

Participants **must register** to attend course – Lunch will be provided. This is a hands-on course designed for solid waste operators and will be instructed by Edmonton Waste Management Centre of Excellence. TSAG will cover the course costs.

NOTE: Each participant is responsible for travel and accommodation arrangements. One participant from each Alberta First Nation will be reimbursed following the workshop. Reimbursement will be paid directly to the Alberta First Nation only (allow 4-6 weeks for reimbursement).
