## Housing Condition Assessment Program

Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) partnered with First Nations Technical Services Advisory Group (TSAG) to facilitate house condition assessments with Alberta First Nation housing departments throughout the 2018/2019 fiscal year.

This program provides tools and training to evaluate the physical condition of homes for short and long-term maintenance planning. HCAP can also be used for assessment of current housing stock to inform future planning and development of housing projects.

### Housing Managers and designated staff will learn:

- How to conduct housing condition assessments
- How to use the TSAG mobile data gathering tool
- How to use subsequent database developed from HCA data
