- Identify different waste stream categories and understand which streams are recyclable and/or recoverable.
- Identify non-compliant waste stream materials.
- Be able to discuss the waste stream challenges within your community with community leaders and outside advisors and consultants.
- Recognize available programs and markets available to your community and how to contact the appropriate support.
- Understand environmental controls and regulations that affect transfer and eco-stations.
- Understand the importance of maintaining a healthy and safe environment through site system management.
- Understand the importance of clear, concise and consistent communication with all site visitors and workers.
- Recognize the importance of data collection for site operation and future reporting.
- Identify the function of key infrastructure elements of a transfer station.
- Understand the issues and challenges associated with planning, designing, and operating a transfer station.
