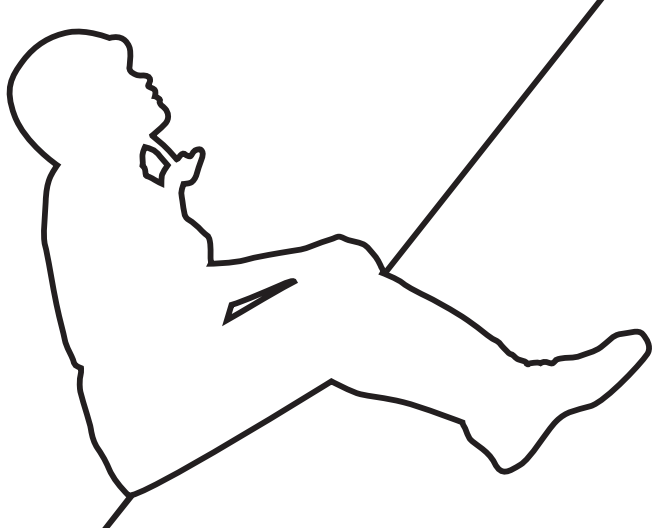
How to apply

TSAG is covering the cost of the camp. Successful applicants will be sent a list of basic personal items to bring. Lodging and food are provided.
