TSAG invited DreamRider Productions to work with Elders and culture keepers to create Indigenous content for their waste reduction Planet Protector Academy: Zero Heroes. The process began early in 2018 and continues to evolve in the spirit of Truth and Reconciliation.



A Mission for Zero Waste

The Planet Protector Academy is a 6-week interactive teaching resource for grades 3-6 called "Zero Heroes" where students learn to think critically about how they can reduce the amount of waste they produce to become Zero Heroes; Heroes that produce less waste! The Zero Hero program is composed of 6 one-hour preplanned lessons that use short videos, interactive classroom activities, and take-home missions. Each Lesson is interdisciplinary and supports curriculum standards for science, art, social studies, and language! All a classroom needs to participate is an internet connection, a computer, and a projector or smartboard.
