Service Agreement Review

Helping community decision makers to move the solid waste system forward by reviewing current agreements and exploring options like used paint, oil, tires and electronics, available for system improvement.

Community Based Decision Making

Support and facilitate a shared interdepartmental approach for synergized solid waste management.

Diversion Support

Building community capacity through stewardship program participation, exploration of partnerships with regional landfill diversion programs, and creation of new community diversion programs.

Measuring and Monitoring

Working with communities to understand waste volumes and characterization through waste auditing. Building capacity at the community level to identify problem waste streams and resource waste streams. Use data to review operations and create efficiencies.



Communications and Education

Co-development of Community-specific Information

Provide templates, presentations, and workshops to build knowledge and expertise within the community with a train the trainer model.

Operator Training

Suite of 12 solid waste management courses for operators approved by Alberta Environment for continuing education units toward Landfill Operator and Compost Operator certification.

Working with site operators and managers to support system changes and member participation.
