They provide support and training to water and wastewater system operators and trainees.


Water Treatment Plant




They plan site visits to follow up on problems they saw during previous site visits.



They help when fire hydrants don't work and need investigation.






They even help Water Operators prepare for special Water Operator exams.



Help the Circuit Riders find their way back to Edmonton.




