December:	Holiday Safety: Identify seasonal and kitchen hazards, fire safety around candles
January:	It's a New Year: STOP, DROP AND ROLL, crawling low in fires, fire escape behaviors and plan
February:	Family and Community: Visit to fire station to learn more about fire prevention
March:	Fire Heroes: Firefighters are community helpers, what gear they wear and how they stay safe
April:	Fire Protection: How to prevent burns, major and minor burns, treating minor burns
May:	Sun, Sun, Summertime : Outdoor activities that are hazardous to children and the environment, how to stay safe in the Summer
We will be encouraging the students to share what they learn with you and our hope is that you are able to use some of the information they share to make your home more secure and fire safe.
